

RULES OF PLAY - GUELPH MINOR BASEBALL ASSOCIATION /GUELPH STORM 50/50 RAFFEL

1. **50/50 Raffel Location :**
Sleeman Center, 50 Woolwich St, Guelph ON.
2. **Age restriction :**
18 years old or over.
3. **Geographic location :**
Sleeman Center, 50 Woolwich St, Guelph ON.
4. **Ticket Price :**
10 numbers for 10\$.
5. **How the tickets are being sold/distributed:**
Using electronic handheld devices provided by ASCENT.
6. **How are the numbers selected?:**
The ticket numbers are randomly generated by the electronic device.
7. **How is the winning ticket selected:**
The winning number is selected by random number by random through the electronic software provider ASCENT.
8. **How is the Prize amount shown/announced/displayed at the event:**
The winning number is shown on display terminals around the arena as well as announced over the PA system, and listed on the GMBA website if uncollected.
9. **How is the ticket purchaser advised on the winning process:**
The ticket purchaser is told that if they win, they attend the GMBA box office location to pick up winnings or contact finance@gmba.ca.
10. **What happens if the selected winner can not attend what happens and how will they be selected.**
GMBA will hold winnings that are uncollected for at least 6 months.
11. **ID REQUIREMENTS TO COLLECT WINNINGS:**
The winner must provide a valid government-issued ID. If ID cannot be presented on-site, the winnings will be held by GMBA until such documentation is provided.
12. **In the event there is not a winner:**
The winning ticket will be kept safely and held for 6 months. After making all efforts to contact the winner, GMBA will then could recommend a donation to a charity, with the approval from the AGCO, after demonstrating all efforts to reach the winner.
13. **Conflict of Interest guidelines.**
Tickets will not be sold to anyone under the age of 18. Tickets will also not be sold to any GMBA board member who declares a conflict of interest with participation in this event.
